Lynne S. Katzmann
To Its Top 25 Woman-Owned Business List**

Montclair, NJ (September 24, 2008) – Crain's New York Business has named Juniper Communities, founded by Lynne S. Katzmann, to its list of the New York Area's Largest Women-Owned Companies coming in at number 19. Juniper was also cited as one of the biggest gainers based on the projected percent change in revenues 2007-2008, and also named to Provider magazine's list of the Top 40 Assisted Living Companies in the United States.

The company is a national owner-operator of assisted living and skilled nursing centers founded by Katzmann twenty years ago. Katzmann is proud that from the beginning, she and her team pioneered an umber of initiatives to improve quality of life for not only residents and staff, but also the communities in which the company operates. For example, she and her team worked to make environmental sustainability a company-wide effort. Ten years ago, Juniper Communities partnered with the then fledgling U.S. Green Building Council in piloting the LEED standards when she decided to build her facility Juniper Village at Chatham, NJ to LEED specifications. It is believed to be the first green assisted living community built in the U.S.

We want our facilities to provide the best possible environment for our residents, and we also want to make the communities we serve healthier places to live,” says Lynne Katzmann.
